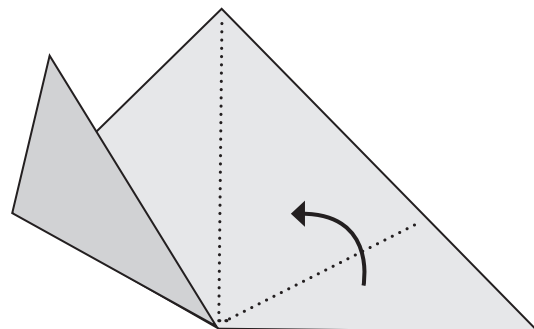
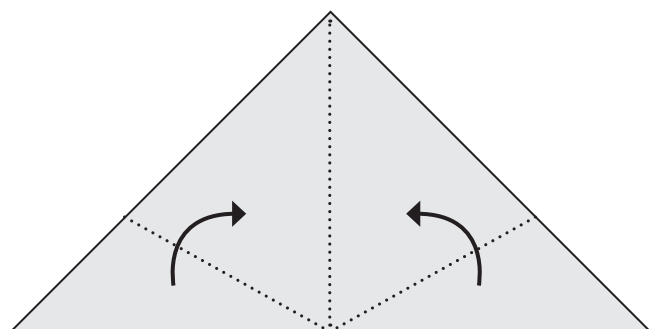
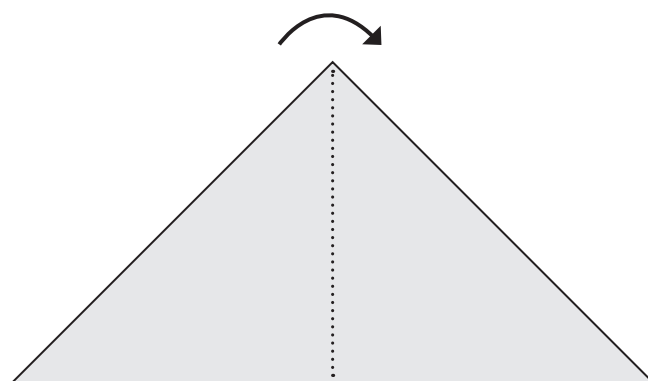
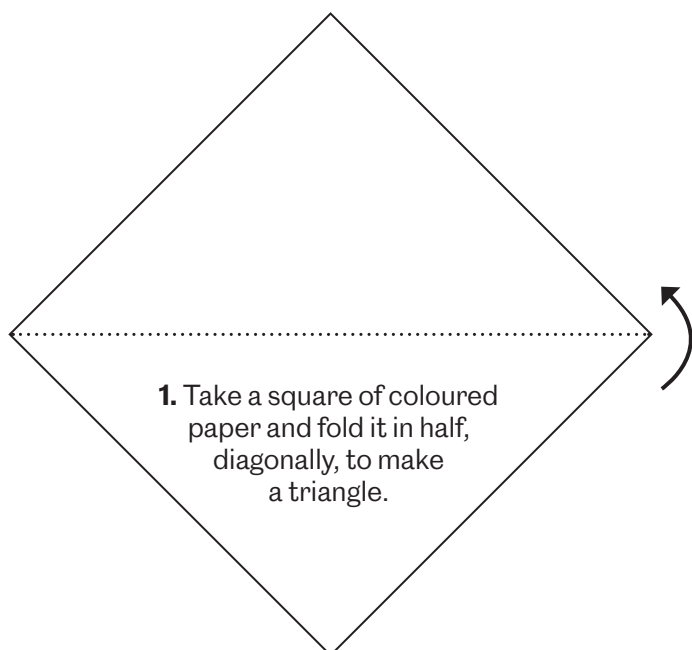


# Origami Tulip (simple)

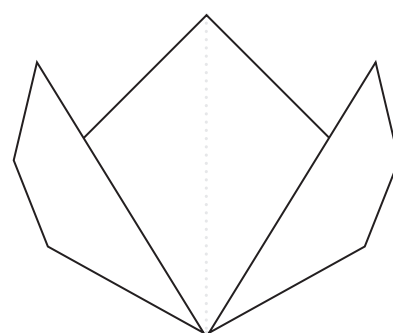
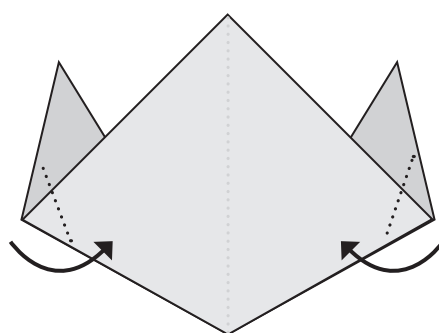
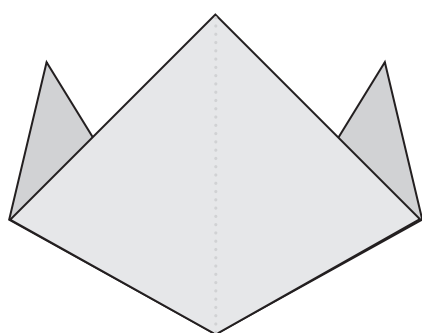


The exhibition is full of beautiful tulips. Make an origami tulip using a 10cm or 15cm square of coloured paper.



3. Open the fold you just made and make sure the folded line is facing upwards.

4. Fold the points on the base of the triangle upwards, as shown.



5. Turn your flower over.

6. Fold back the sides of the flower, as shown.

7. Turn your flower over. You've made a tulip!

**If you'd like to make a stalk for your tulip, you can stick it to a pipe cleaner, lolly stick or straw. Or you can make an origami stalk (see separate instructions).**
