
## Origami Tulip (simple)




The exhibition is full of beautiful tulips. Make an origami tulip using a 10cm or 15cm square of coloured paper.




**3.** Open the fold you just made and make sure the folded line is facing upwards.


**4.** Fold the points on the base of the triangle upwards, as shown.



**5.** Turn your flower over.



**6.** Fold back the sides of the flower, as shown.



7. Turn your flower over. You've made a tulip!

If you'd like to make a stalk for your tulip, you can stick it to a pipe cleaner, lolly stick or straw. Or you can make an origami stalk (see separate instructions).
